Foreign Corporations (Out-of-State Entities)

Prior to transacting business in the state of Wisconsin, foreign (out-of-state) entities must register their business with the WI Department of Financial Institutions (DFI) or be subject to penalty fees – www.wdfi.org/corporations/forms. Certification with the WI Supplier Diversity Program requires businesses, including out-of-state corporations and LLCs, be registered with DFI. See chart below for information on how to register Corporations and LLCs. All other business entities should contact DFI.

- Your business will be registered as a legal entity in WI once the Form is filed.
- Each year in January, DFI will mail a postcard notification to your business's registered office to file the annual report, which is due March 31st.
- To remain in good standing, an Annual Report must be filed each year. The Annual Report base filing fee is \$65, plus additional fees based upon Form information provided by your business.
- If entity has transacted business in Wisconsin prior to filing the form, there will be a penalty. The calculation for the penalty is on the document.
